Friday, July 8th

Park your cars at our farm near Appleton, MN and join us for the experience of a lifetime! North to Alaska! Sit back, relax and leave all the details to us. We have an interesting couple of weeks planned for you! We depart for the Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport. Our flight takes us to Vancouver, British Columbia where we spend the night.

Saturday, July 9th

Enjoy a city tour of Vancouver, BC this morning. This afternoon we board Holland America Cruise Line's MS Nieuw Amsterdam where we will spend the next three nights cruising the Inside Passage. Holland America Cruise Line continually earns the industry's premium five-star rating. They are recognized for elegance, fine dining, and a level of graciousness that rises above every expectation. Sunday, July 10th

Today just sit back and relax and enjoy the beautiful scenery that Alaska's Inside Passage has to offer! The MS Nieuw Amsterdam has many amenities for you to enjoy along the way. This relatively new ship has a health spa, movie theatre, library, casino, beauty salon, tennis courts, swimming pools, and three restaurants! Or just sit on one of the many decks that have lounge chairs for you to pass the time away viewing the scenery, or maybe sighting a dolphin or killer whale along the way! Overnight on board ship. (B,L,D)

Monday, July 11th

Enjoy scenic cruising this morning as we get closer to Tracy Arm. This year we have added a side tour where you will board a catamaran right from the cruise ship and get up close to the Tracy Arm Fjord and the Sawyer Glaciers. This will be a wonderful opportunity to witness what naturalist John Muir called "one of the most dramatically stunning fjords of Southeast Alaska." This afternoon we have a stop in Alaska's capitol...Juneau. Juneau is only accessible by air or sea. Overnight on board ship. (B,L,D)

Tuesday, July 12th

We disembark our cruise ship this morning and enjoy the town of Skagway, Alaska. History never gets old in Skagway. This Klondike Gold Rush National Historic Park boasts restored buildings and wooden boardwalks that invite you to stroll into the past. Take your time and poke into every little store, from the Trail Bench to Lynch & Kennedy's Dry Goods. The Red Onion Saloon, with its honky-tonk piano and costumed barmaids, is a treasure trove of memorabilia. We continue by traveling the White Pass & Yukon Railroad up the mountain out of Skagway. We then board a waiting motorcoach for our short journey to Whitehorse, Yukon Territory where we spend the night. Overnight Whitehorse, YT (B,D)

Wednesday, July 13th

This morning we make our way north to where the gold rush all started! In the summer of 1896, a small cadre of prospectors making their way along Bonanza Creek, a tributary of the Klondike River, stumbled upon huge quantities of gold. Word of the discovery spread slowly until the next summer, when word hit Seattle and San Francisco. The Klondike Gold Rush ignited, and the town of Dawson sprang into being to serve the floodtide of prospectors. Located at the confluence of the Yukon and Klondike Rivers, Dawson is now a National Historic Site that has turned back the clock to preserve a rich living history. Meander the wooden boardwalks with costumed townsfolk ready to share their home and its national historic treasures. Enjoy the old fashioned "Gold Rush" days and feel that this town has to offer. Overnight Dawson, YT (B,L,D)

Thursday, July 14th

Sleep in a bit today, and then continue to explore this little town where the Gold Rush started. We enjoy an included cruise aboard the Klondike Spirit Paddle wheeler on the Yukon River. Overnight Dawson, YT (B,D)

Friday, July 15th

Today we take a short flight from Dawson to Fairbanks, AK. We hope you enjoyed the city of Dawson and got a bit of the "Gold Rush Fever" as we prepare to pan for gold later on in Fairbanks! Overnight Fairbanks, Alaska. (B,D)

Saturday, July 16th

We pan for gold this morning at the authentic Gold Dredge No. 8 which is listed on the register of National Historic Sites. After that we venture south to Denali National Park where we spend the next two nights. Overnight McKinley Chalet, Denali, AK (B,L,D)

Sunday, July 17th

This morning you will have time to do some whitewater rafting, golfing, guided horseback tours, helicopter ride to Mt. McKinley or just browse throu the many shops that Denali has for us to visit. This afternoon we take the Denali National Park Tundra Wilderness Tour. This six to eight hour tour takes you into the heart of Denali National Park. Watch for caribou, grizzlies, moose, Dall sheep and more. Keep your eye out for Mt. McKinley today. There will be many dramatic lookout points along this journey. Overnight McKinley Chalet in Denali. (B,D)

Monday, July 18th

This morning we board the McKinley Explorer luxury domed railcar and enjoy our journey south to Anchorage. This afternoon we check into our hotel and enjoy an included evening meal. Overnight in Anchorage. (B,L,D)

Tuesday, July 19th

Today is a free day to explore Anchorage. Enjoy Alaska's largest city. This evening we take a red eye flight home to Minnesota. (L)

Wednesday, July 20th

We land in Minneapolis where we will have transportation arranged to take you back to Appleton this morning. We hope you enjoyed the trip of a lifetime to Alaska, and would like to thank you for traveling with WD Tours.

In 2016 there are a few highlights to mention about the tour. Holland America has limited their groups to 44 passengers per motorcoach. This means there will be more room per passenger on board the coach. This also means that after Holland America has signed up 44 people on the tour there will be a waiting list! Sign up early so you can be assured of getting a seat on board that coach! **(One year the trip was sold out by Thanksgiving. Either the ship gets full, or the motorcoach or hotels on the land portion of the tour get full, so if you want to go on this tour, it is important that you sign up early!)**

Over the years our customers said they were glad we incorporated the many forms of travel on this tour. They also were very appreciative of the quality of the hotels, and the fact we included a meal plan for them. Many of our customers had prime rib or salmon or king crab for their evening meal, and that \$40 - \$80 meal was included in their tour package. They felt they saved a bunch of money by having the meal plan in place for them.

The tour payment schedule is as follows:

\$1000 due on or before October 31st
\$1000 due January 1st
Balance due February 1st

The cancellation policy is as follows:

Cancel on or before February 1st - Full Trip Refund
Cancel between February 1st and April 1st - Lose \$2500
Cancel after April 1st - Lose full tour cost

Trip insurance needs to be purchased before the final payment is made in February.
