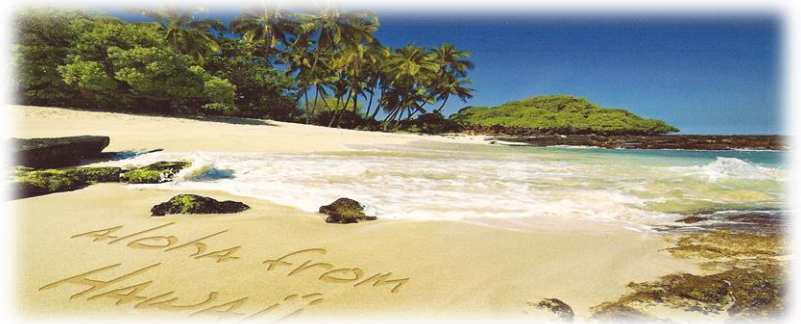

Hawaii Itinerary

Tuesday, December 27, 2016

We board the mini-coach early this morning and start our journey to Hawaii. Our non-stop flight departs from MSP arriving in Honolulu this afternoon. Welcome to Hawaii and Aloha! Overnight Waikiki.

Wednesday, December 28, 2016

Today we get up close and personal with some sea creatures! Snorkeling in Hanauma Bay is a wonderful way to kick off your Hawaii adventure. The bay has over 400 species of colorful tropical fish. After a brief snorkeling lesson, you can explore the rich coral reef and its species of fish, or you may want to just stay on the beach and relax. Overnight Waikiki. Breakfast included today.

Thursday, December 29, 2016

Oahu is famous for its North Shore area where surfers from all over the world come to surf in its high waves. During this captivating, wraparound "Circle Island" adventure, you will be swept off to the island's most awe-inspiring landmarks and destinations, including the world-famous Hanauma Bay, the spouting "Blow Hole," Pali Lookout and the sacred Kualoa Ranch nestled against the stunning Koolau Mountains. The Dole Plantation is a stop where we will learn about the pineapple industry, and don't forget some of that famous Dole whip ice cream! Overnight Waikiki. Breakfast included today.

Friday, December 30, 2016

You can still smell the oil floating to the surface around the USS Arizona. Can you imagine what that December day was like? We visit the moving and historic site of the USS Arizona Memorial where 1177 men are still entombed today. A tour of the Battleship Missouri where WWII officially ended is included. We also pay a visit to the Pacific Aviation Museum. This afternoon we take a tour of Honolulu including Punchbowl National Cemetery. Overnight Waikiki. Breakfast included today.

Saturday, December 31, 2016

Enjoy the day to meander around Waikiki. Late this afternoon we go to the Paradise Cove Luau where you can make an Orchid bracelet, a headband out of palm tree leaves, participate in traditional Hawaiian games and more. Your evening luau meal is included followed by a traditional Polynesian show put on by Paradise Cove. Tonight we get back to Waikiki in time to enjoy the fireworks on Waikiki beach. Happy New Year! Overnight Waikiki. Breakfast and evening meal included today.

Sunday, January 1, 2017

It is a short flight to the island of Maui. Today we have the rest of the day to enjoy our beautiful Westin Resort on Maui. The Westin Maui Resort & Spa is situated along a spectacular stretch of the famed Ka'anapali Beach. This oceanfront resort blends an endless array of activities and amenities with gracious aloha spirit. Overnight Maui. Breakfast included today.
