

Door County Tour Itinerary

Join us for our late summer tour to Door County! We hope to arrive just in time to enjoy some freshly picked cherries.

Monday, July 28, 2025

Park your cars at Wes and Karen's house this morning and join us for a relaxing 4-day tour to the Cape Cod of the Midwest.... scenic Door County, Wisconsin! Today we make our way across Minnesota and the Badger state to Door County, a 75-mile-long peninsula in Wisconsin that has 250+ miles of shoreline, quaint little towns, Scandinavian Roots, scenic landscapes, orchards, wineries and more. Our noon meal stop will be Marieke Gouda. This young lady longed for the quality Gouda cheese she had growing up in the Netherlands. She married a dairy farmer and the rest is history. We will spend some time touring their farm and cheesemaking process. We also will stop in Shawano and pay a visit to Twiggs Beverage and museum where our local Sundrop is bottled. Overnight at the Churchill Inn, an English themed hotel with wonderful included breakfasts. Overnight Sister Bay, Wisconsin



Tuesday, July 29, 2025

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel.

Today we visit a local cherry producer. We learn about the growing of cherries, the harvesting and processing of the cherries. We then get to spend time in their shop to browse and shop for some of the local specialties that they produce.

Today's included noon meal will be at Wild Tomato, a local pizza favorite! After lunch we visit the Island Lavender Market where all things lavender are sold.

High above the Peninsula's northeast shore stands one of the most popular attractions in Door County. Eagle Tower, located on top of Eagle Bluff, offers panoramic views of the park, surrounding islands, the Upper Michigan shoreline and the village of Ephraim. We can utilize the ramp and take a leisurely stroll to the top of the tower.

Perched on a bluff 76 feet above Green Bay's glistening waters, Eagle Bluff Lighthouse's lamp brought solace to many a sailor suffering through a storm's gale or the dark of night. Today the tradition of the lighthouse continues. Restored to its past glory, by the Door County Historical Society, Eagle Bluff Lighthouse is a tribute to the keepers who kept the lamp burning on many a dark and stormy night. This lighthouse will be the next stop on our tour today.

On our way south this afternoon we will get into the Christmas spirit with a visit to the Mistletoe House which is packed full of Christmas treasures, followed by a visit to the Door Peninsula Winery and Distillery.

This evening enjoy an included evening meal at Pelletier's Fish Boil. Fish boiling was brought to the peninsula in the late 1800's by Scandinavian immigrants needed an economical way to feed large groups of workers. A chicken dinner option is also available. Wednesday, July 30. 2025

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel.

"Yacht Works is a local yacht sales, repair and Marina in Sister Bay. Today we will visit their facility and learn about the yacht industry. They store over 400 boats indoors every winter! Next up the Tannenbaum store is an old church built in 1879 and has been transformed into a store full of Christmas items for sale! Enjoy some time browsing through their store.

For our noon meal today, we enjoy an included Swedish Pancake meal at the Famous Al Johnson's restaurant. Be sure to look up on the roof and see the goats grazing on the sod roof.

No visit to Bailey's Harbor would be complete without experiencing the iconic Baileys Harbor Range Lights. Built in 1869 and added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1989, the Upper Range Light and its companion Lower Range Light are the only lighthouses of this design that are still on range and functional as navigational aids. These modest but enduring structures played a critical role in the history of Baileys Harbor and in the founding of The Ridges. The Ridges is one of the Midwest's most biologically diverse ecosystems, where we experience more than a walk in the woods.

Next stop will be the Boynton Chapel at Bjorklunden. The Boynton Chapel is a small wooden chapel built in a late 12th-century Norwegian stave church (Stavkirke) style. Handcrafted by Winifred and Donald Boynton between 1939 and 1947 on the grounds of their summer residence, the chapel is modeled after the Garmo stave church at Maihaugen in Lillehammer, Norway. This a favorite stop among Door County tourists. The chapel contains 41 hand-painted frescoes and numerous exceptionally fine carved-wood furnishings.

On our way back to Sister Bay today we will pay a visit to another one of Door County's wineries and orchards. Enjoy wine tasting and their store packed with baked goods, jams, jellies and many other treats and crafts.

Late this afternoon we enjoy an included evening meal at the LURE restaurant which is just across the street from our hotel.

Thursday, July 31, 2025

After an included breakfast we begin our journey back home. We stop at the Wood Orchard to have one more opportunity to make your Door County cherry and other food purchases. A stop at Doc's Harley Davidson and Museum in Shawano will be sure to entertain you. His collection is amazing! We make our usual rest and meal stops along the way arriving back home late this evening. (B)
