Sunday, June 13, 2027

Monday, June 14, 2027

Included breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy an included dinner while we make tracks to one of the most famous racetracks in the United States, the Indianapolis Motor Speedway and Museum. It is one of the oldest and most revered motor sports facilities in the world. The Museum has become one of the world's premier collections of racing automobiles and artifacts—with more than 55,000 artifacts and over 300 vehicles. The Indianapolis Motor Speedway Museum has been named one of USA Today's Top Three Best Sports Attractions in the Country. We also take a ride around the track where the Indy 500 is held! Tuesday, June 15, 2027

Begin the day with an included breakfast at the hotel before departing for the incredible Creation Museum. The state-of-the-art Creation Museum allows us to venture through biblical history, stunning exhibits, botanical gardens, planetarium, zoo, a zip line adventure course and so much more. The Creation Museum shows why God's infallible Word, rather than man's faulty assumptions, is the place to begin if we want to make sense of our world. This 75,000-square-foot facility allows families to experience earth history as God has revealed it in the Bible. Nearly 150 exhibits feature fearsome animatronic dinosaurs, talking heroes of the faith, and professional displays that honor God's Word. The museum also boasts a fun-filled, 200-seat special effects theater, a state-of-the-art planetarium, a Children's Zoo, nature trails, and lots more. At the heart of the Creation Museum is a chronological retelling of biblical history in seven parts called the Seven C's. You will step back in time, beginning with Creation, and fast-forward to Christ's return. Along the way, you see how God's Word provides the big-picture answers for our most difficult questions, whether about science, the Bible, or our personal relationship with God. This evening we relax while onboard the Belle of Cincinnati Riverboat cruise. The 2 to 2.5-hour cruise features a chef-prepared buffet dinner, live entertainment, and scenic views of the city skyline. Overnight Florence, KY (B,S)

Wednesday, June 16, 2027

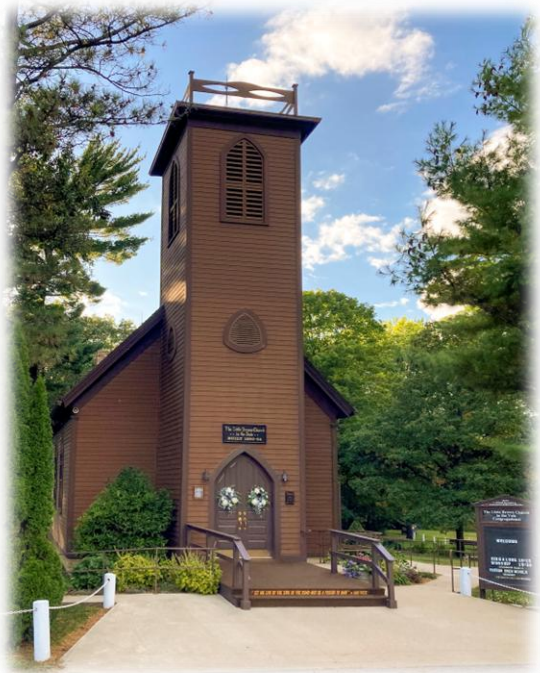

Have you ever wondered how large Noah's Ark really was? How did Noah fit all the animals aboard? How were they fed and cared for? And how could Noah have built such an enormous vessel? Today, we'll have the opportunity to explore those questions as we step aboard a life-size replica of Noah's Ark, built according to the dimensions given in the Bible. Measuring an amazing 510 feet long, 85 feet wide, and 51 feet high, the Ark is an impressive sight that must be seen to be fully appreciated. Inside, we'll explore three decks filled with world-class exhibits that bring the biblical account of Noah to life. Discover how Noah and his family may have lived aboard the Ark, how the animals could have been housed and cared for, and how this massive vessel may have been constructed. The Ark Encounter also offers additional attractions, including a zoo and ziplining opportunities. Following our visit to the Ark Encounter, we'll make a special stop at Patriot's Landing, an organization dedicated to supporting veterans through purposeful work, faith, and fellowship. In its woodshop, veterans create beautiful handcrafted products while working alongside others who understand the challenges and sacrifices of military service. Patriot's Landing provides a supportive, faith-based environment where veterans can find camaraderie, purpose, and encouragement. It's more than a workshop—it's a mission in motion. After a memorable and inspiring day, we'll make our way to Crawfordsville, IN where we enjoy an included pizza supper. Overnight Crawfordsville, IN. (B,S)

Thursday, June 17, 2027

After an included breakfast at the hotel we venture north to Amana, Iowa where we start our visit with an included family style meal at the Ox Yoke Inn, followed by a guided tour of the Amana area, and have a bit of shopping time in Amana. Overnight Amana, IA. (B,D,S)

Luverne is also home to the third-largest nutcracker collection in the world thanks to resident Betty Mann, who collected more than 6,000 nutcrackers and then donated her collection to the town's History Center that we will visit.
